Framing the interview

Creating good circumstances:

- Choosing a good location/environment
- What impression did she give?
- Documentation
 - Recording the interview?
 - Taking notes?



Beginning the interview

- Did she introduce herself?
- Did she introduce the study?
 - they interview process?
 - assure that the respondent understands and trusts confidentiality
 - informed consent?
 - ask for permission to record?
- Did she give them time to recall typical episodes/experiences?



Interviewing...

- Did she put interviewee at ease?
- Was she non-judgemental in her attitude?
- Was she a good listener?
- Did she allow for "silence" (pauses)?
- Did she give time to interviewee?
- Did she use the interview guide, while still being flexible?



Role of probing

- Did she get the participant to expand upon their answers?
 - to give more details?
 - to add additional perspectives

Non-verbal communication?

- Nodding, encouraging
- Open, relaxed posture, (slightly lean toward interviewee – shows interest)
- Eye contact (varied)
- Gestures
